### MEMBERSHIP DUES EXPLANATIONS/INSTRUCTIONS

<u>Class A</u> - \$35 for Apple Growers (owner or First person) **PLUS** \$.50 per acre of Apples. Additionally, the spouse/employees of your farm are \$35 per person. Any staff/spouse attending the Annual Convention in Hershey must pay dues to receive the discounted registration rate. The discount covers the membership fee. Example: If you grow 100 acres of Apples, your Dues would be \$35 plus \$50.00 for a total of \$85. If your spouse and 2 sons (or employees) also join it is an additional \$105 for a total dues of \$190.00.

Class B — Other Crops — Members who do not grow Apples pay \$50 per person/farm.

<u>Class C</u> – Commercial Member – For businesses -- banks, chemical suppliers, labor consultants, etc. The fee is \$75 for the first employee and \$35 for each additional employee. (This membership also entitles the employees to the discounted registration rate at the convention.) Example: Company has 5 employees to register, the rate is \$75 plus \$140 for a total of \$215.00.

Class D - Out of State or Students - This is a flat rate of \$35 Per person/company or employee.

<u>Class E</u> – Professional/Subscription – This rate is reserved for Scientist, Extension Agents, Employees of the Employment Commission, or other government agencies affiliated with the Apple Industry and is a flat rate of \$35 per person. If VDACS has 3 employees to register for membership the fee would be \$105 and qualifies the employees for the membership advanced registration rate at the Hershey convention.

<u>Donations/Sponsors:</u> You can optionally send funds to support the Virginia Apple Research Program (VARP) or the VSH Society as well (if you are a sponsor of our Annual Breakfast, you can include your sponsorship on the VSH Society line).

<u>Subscriptions</u>: If you wish to receive your discounted subscription(s) to Good Fruit Grower and/or Fruit Grower News, simply include those funds as well.

<u>Women's Auxiliary:</u> Membership in the Women's Auxiliary is managed by the Women's Auxiliary. I am grateful to the women who have dual membership to both the Virginia State Horticultural Society and the Women's Auxiliary (that is perfectly acceptable and again, much appreciated, we need you!) However, if your intension is to be a member of the Women's Auxiliary only, the membership form will be sent to you separately, the dues are set by the Women's Auxiliary and paid to their Treasurer.





# University of Virginia launches critical labor migration study

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the number of guest-worker visas issued has increased fourfold in the last decade, but the H-2A visa program for temporary agricultural workers still isn't keeping pace with the nation's growing demand for agricultural labor. The current program has also been criticized for leaving workers without the same protections the domestic labor force enjoys, which could further undermine the stability of a migrant labor force.

Each year USApple puts together its Industry Outlook report which provides the most upto-date data and analysis on U.S. and global apple production, utilization and trade. Authored by USApple Vice President of Insights and Analytics, Chris Gerlach, the report takes an in-depth look at the trends and forces – from political headwinds to weather events – that shape the U.S. apple industry. These estimates will be reevaluated in December 2024 when inventory from the USAppleTracker monthly storage report will be used to gauge their appropriateness. The final production figures will not be known until the USDA releases its revised figures in May 2025.

### **EPA Endangered Species Protection Program**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) <u>Endangered Species Protection Program</u> is designed to determine whether pesticide use in a certain geographic area may affect any listed species. If limitations on pesticide use are necessary to protect listed species in that area, the information is relayed through Endangered Species Protection Bulletins. In Virginia, the program is administered by the VDACS Office of Pesticide Services.


